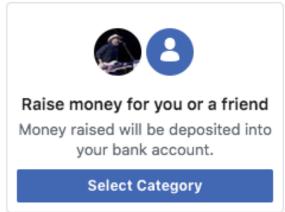
- 1. Type into web browser facebook.com/fundraisers

3. Type 'KKFI' into the search bar.

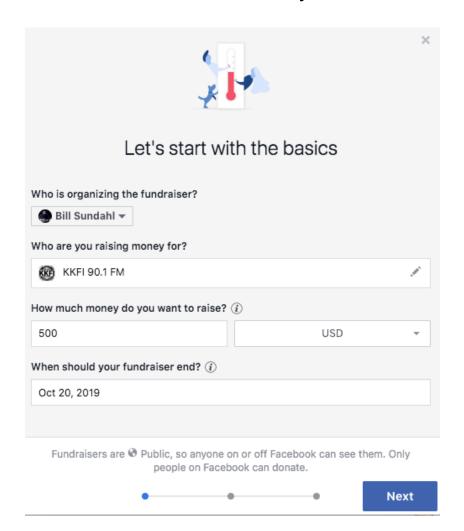


4a. Select Who is Organizing the Fundraiser

 - d. I think between \$500 and \$1000 for most programs is a good target.

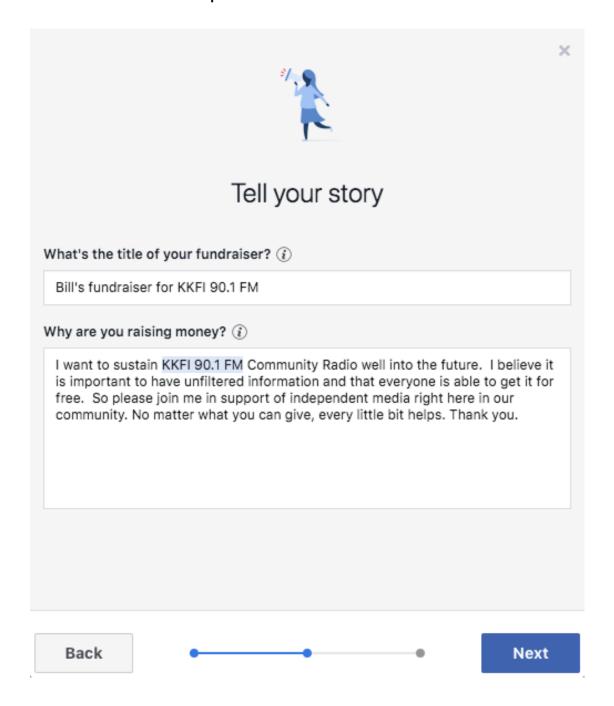
4d. When should your fundraiser end?

e. Choose the final day of this fund drive. Oct. 20th, 2019.

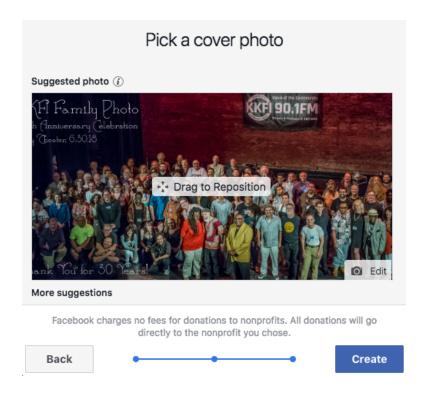


5. Explain why you give to KKFI

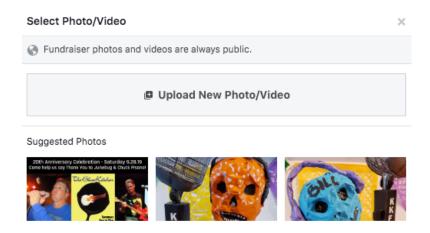
- Include personal stories and why you think others should too.

7. Click 'Create'

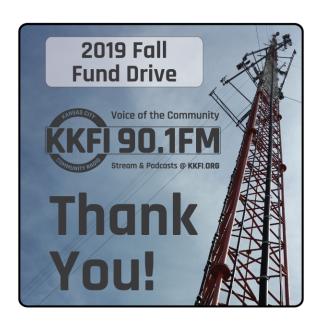
- YOU DID IT!
